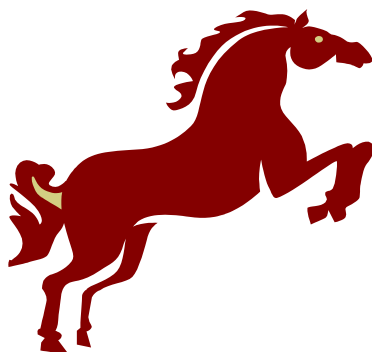
Home Access Center (HAC) - Parents and students have the ability to check the HAC. This is where you can stay up to date on your child's grades. Teachers update HAC weekly.

Lockers

Students should keep their locker combination private and not share with friends or

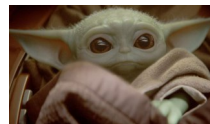
fellow students.
