WHAT ABOUT WORLD LANGUAGE?

- If you are currently taking a World Language and have a B or higher, we suggest you continue with that language in 9th grade.
- If you are currently taking STEM and wish to take a language, you can take Spanish 1, French 1 or Chinese Mandarin 1 in 9th grade.
- World Language is NOT a requirement for graduation but 2-3 years may be necessary for specific majors or to get into some colleges. (Penn State requires 2 years)
